Ms. Jerichow will have the parent update the child information card to include their signature and date. R 400.1916(13)(d)	During the inspection, I observed a 4-month-old infant sleeping in a bassinet attachment connected to a play yard.	Ms. Jerichow has removed the bassinet attachment and it will not be used at the child care. All child care staff members will retake the safe sleep training and she will provide this	06/13/2022

		documentation to the department. To maintain compliance, Ms. Jerichow will review sleeping equipment rules with staff and then twice a year.	
R 400.1931(2)(c)	During the inspection, I witnessed a 30-month-old female and an 18-month-old male served grapes during lunch. The grapes were whole and not cut up.	Ms. Jerichow has instructed staff that children cannot be served uncut grapes. Ms. Jerichow has reviewed choking hazards rules with all child care staff members. Ms. Jerichow will monitor meal times daily to ensure children are not served foods which present as a choking hazard to children under 3 years of age.	06/13/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
