
During the renewal inspection on 2/27/2023, I found 14 violations. The violation is listed below and explained in the attached report:

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and

training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1905            Training.**

**(1) A licensee shall complete not less than 10 clock hours of training each calendar year related to child development, program planning, and administrative management for a child care business, not including CPR, first aid, and infectious disease, including immunizations, training.**

Licensee does not have documented 10 hours of training for 2021 or 2022.

**R 400.1905            Training.**

**(2) A child care staff member and a child care assistant shall complete not less than 5 clock hours of training each calendar year related to child development and caring for children, not including CPR, first aid, and infectious disease, including immunizations, training.**

Child care staff member Victor Jenkins does not have 5 hours of training documented for 2021 or 2022.

**R 400.1905            Training.**

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

- (a) Safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome.
- (b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.
- (c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment

Child care staff member Victor Jenkins does not have documentation showing training in Safe sleep, recognizing child abuse and neglect, prevention of shaken baby syndrome prior to caring for children.

**R 400.1905                    Training.**

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

- (a) Child development.
- (b) Administration of medication.
- (c) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.
- (d) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants.
- (e) Precautions in transporting children.
- (f) Building and physical premises safety.
- (g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

Child care staff member Victor Jenkins has not taken Health and Safety 1 and 2.

**R 400.1905                    Training**

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Licensee has not taken Health and safety refreshers in 2021, 2022 or 2023.

**R 400.1906                    Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.**

(1) A licensee shall maintain a file for each child care staff member and each child care assistant that includes all of the following:

(b) Daily records detailing arrival times and departure times at the child care home.

Licensee is not keeping attendance for self and child care staff members.

**R 400.1907            Child's records.**

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.

13 of the 19 child information cards were not filled out in their entirety

**R 400.1907            Child's records.**

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(b) A child in care statement or receipt using a form provided by the department and signed by the parent certifying all of the following:

(i) Receipt of a written disciplinary policy.

(ii) Condition of the child's health.

(iii) Acknowledgement that the parent has been offered either a copy of the licensing rules for a child care home or has been given the website for an electronic copy of these rules.

(iv) Agreement as to who will provide food for the child.

(v) Acknowledgement that firearms are on the premises, if applicable.

(vi) If the child care home was built prior to 1978, then the licensee shall inform the parents of each child in care and all personnel of the potential presence of lead-based paint or lead dust hazards, unless the licensee maintains documentation from a lead testing professional that the home is lead safe.

19 of 19 child in care statements are on the old form, not filled out completely, not signed or dated.

**R 400.1907            Child's records.**

(2) Records in subrule (1) of this rule must be reviewed and updated annually or when information changes.

Seven of 19 child information cards were not updated annually. 19 of 19 child in care statements were not updated annually.

**R 400.1915 Indoor space; play equipment and materials.**

(5) As required by section 15 of the children's product safety act, 2000 PA 219, MCL 722.1065, a licensee shall conspicuously post in the child care home an updated copy of the list of recalled or unsafe children's products that is provided by the department through its Michigan Child Care Matters (MCCM) online newsletter and available at the department's website [www.michigan.gov/mccmatters](http://www.michigan.gov/mccmatters).

There was not a current recall notice posted at the home.

**R 400.1919 Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.**

(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

(6) The documents required in this rule must be retained by the licensee for a minimum of 4 years from the date the individual no longer resides in or cares for children in the child care home.

There were no records on file for TB results for Bonney Jenkins, Victor Jenkins, or Jonathan Jenkins.

**R 400.1925 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.**

(2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:

(e) Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.

Licensee has individuals connected in the CCBC who no longer work at or live at the child care home.

**R 400.1941 Heat-producing equipment.**

(2) Combustible materials and equipment must not be stored within 4 feet of furnaces,

other flame or heat-producing equipment, or fuel-fired water heaters.

There is not a 4 ft clearance around the furnace and water heater.

**R 400.1945            Emergency; plan; drill.**

1) An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home.

The plan must address the following types of emergencies:

(e) Crisis management including, but not limited to, all of the following:

- (i) Intruders.
- (ii) Active shooters.
- (iii) Bomb threats.
- (iv) Other man- or woman-caused events.

Licensee does not have written plans for crisis management including active shooters, bomb threats, other man-or- woman caused events.

**Technical assistance and consultation:**

**R400.1903(1)(l)** Licensee will have a policy/procedure regarding the screening of volunteers

**R400.1903(8)(b)** Licensee will post a no vaping sign

**R400.1907(3)** Licensee will ensure child attendance records are completed and accurate.

**R400.1913(1)** Licensee will ensure discipline states no timeouts for children under age 3

**R400.1914(4)** licensee will ensure TV/electronics is limited to two hours a day.


**R400.1918(2)** Licensee will have an annual topical permission slip signed by parents for children enrolled

**R400.1936(5)** Licensee will ensure all pet food and supplies are inaccessible to children.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 02/27/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license (capacity 12).
