Dear Ms. Mobley:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 10/28/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During the onsite inspection I observed children engaged in free play and being fed a bottle. The children appeared happy and bonded to caregivers. Caregivers appeared nurturing and kind.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1907 Child's records.

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.

Three of the five child information cards reviewed did not have documentation of permission for emergent treatment, special needs/allergies, and date of attendance documented.

Child's records.

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(b) A child in care statement or receipt using a form provided by the department and signed by the parent certifying all of the following:

(i) Receipt of a written disciplinary policy.

(ii) Condition of the child's health.

(iii) Acknowledgement that the parent has been offered either a copy of the licensing rules for a child care home or has been given the website for an electronic copy of these rules.

(iv) Agreement as to who will provide food for the child.

(v) Acknowledgement that firearms are on the premises, if applicable.

(vi) If the child care home was built prior to 1978, then the licensee shall inform the parents of each child in care and all personnel of the potential presence of lead-based paint or lead dust hazards, unless the licensee maintains documentation from a lead testing professional that the home is lead safe.

One of the five child in care statements were not signed by parent.

Child's records.

(2) Records in subrule (1) of this rule must be reviewed and updated annually or when information changes.

Three of the five child-in-care statements were not updated yearly, last updated in 2017, 2018 and 2018 respectively.

R 400.1931 Food preparation and service.

(13) Children shall not have beverage or food containers when they are in bed or when they are walking around or playing.

The was one infant who had a bottle which was not labeled with first name, last name and dated.

R 400.1931 Food preparation and service.

(8) Bottles used for feeding must be labeled with the child's first and last name and date, refrigerated, and served only to the child on the label.

There was a child walking around with his cup in the play area.

R 400.1932 Home maintenance and safety.

(1) The structure, premises, and furnishings of a child care home must be in good repair and maintained in a clean, safe, and comfortable condition.

There is a hole in the living room, behind the door.

R 400.1932 Home maintenance and safety.

(2) All dangerous and hazardous materials or items must be stored securely and out of the reach of children.

There was a bottle of cleaning products in the bathroom accessible to children.

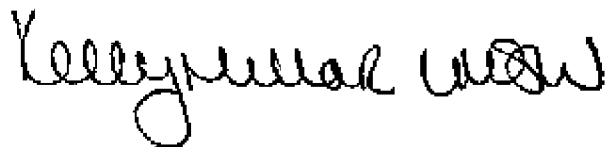
