The terms of the original license have been modified on 01/08/2019, 08/09/2022, and 02/07/2023.

The group child care home is a single-story dwelling in a residential area within the city of Mt. Morris.

The approved child use space is the living room, dining room, kitchen, and one bathroom – all on the main level of the home. The home has three remote exits on the main level (the front door, the back door, and the side door). The large playroom in the basement is approved as child use space. The basement has two remote exits (an approved emergency egress window for exiting and the stairs leading to the main level of the home).

The home has a variety of age-appropriate equipment to meet the overall capacity.

Ms. Smith does not transport or provide overnight care.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the large room in the basement as child use space.
