

R 400.1945(4)	Fire drills must be practiced while children are in care at least once quarterly, and a written record that includes the date and time it takes to evacuate must be maintained.
R 400.1945(1)	An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home. The plan must address the following types of emergencies:
R 400.1944(3)	A home shall have at least 1 functioning multipurpose fire extinguisher, with a rating of 2A'(10) BC or larger, properly mounted not higher than 5 feet from the floor to the top of the fire extinguisher, on each floor level approved for child use.
