R400.1904a(2)(c) Child care staff member; employment requirements.	Child care staff member Christine Emmendorfer was not trained in the prevention of infectious disease, including immunizations before caring for children. This training is available via MiRegistry Health and Safety 1&2.	Ms. Blocker understands that this training needed to be completed prior to Ms. Emmendorfer working and will have her complete them.	07/20/2022

R400.1905(3) Training.	Ms. Emmendorfer was not trained on safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome, recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect, or prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment prior to caring for children. This training, with the exception of safe sleep practices, is available via MiRegistry Health and Safety 1&2.	Ms. Blocker understands that this training needed to be completed prior to Ms. Emmendorfer working and will have her complete them.	07/20/2022
R400.1905(4) Training.	Ms. Emmendorfer was not trained on the subjects above within 90 days of her date of hire. These trainings are available via MiRegistry Health and Safety 1&2. R400.1932(6) Home maintenance and safety.	Area manager Crecendra Brown and I observed that the large play structure and the swing set had a large amount of flaking paint that was accessible to the children.	Ms. Blocker understands that the paint chips need to be corrected and is in the process of hiring a painter. She will monitor it for additional corrections.	07/27/2022
R400.1935(1) Firearms.	Ms. Brown and I observed 2 handguns lying in an open drawer on the upper level of the home. Mr. Blocker confirmed that they were unloaded and upon my request he installed a trigger lock onto each.	Ms. Blocker just recently obtained the 2 handguns and will continue to monitor that they are locked unloaded.	06/29/2022
R400.1935(2) Firearms.	Ms. Brown and I observed that the ammunition for the 2 handguns was in an unlocked wooden box in the same room as the handguns. Upon my request, Mr. Blocker locked the ammunition in a fire safe within the room.	Ms. Blocker just recently obtained the 2 handguns and will continue to monitor that their ammunition is locked separately from the handguns.	06/29/2022
R400.1941(2) Heat-producing equipment.	Ms. Brown and I observed combustibles within 4 feet of the furnace and fuel-fired water heater. I advised that they measure 4 feet in circumference and tape it off as a reminder.	Ms. Blocker will maintain combustibles no closer than 4 feet from her furnace and eater heater by taping it off as a reminder.	06/29/2022

R400.1931(1)(a) Food preparation and service.	Ms. Brown and I observed that Ms. Blocker did not have low-fat milk available to serve the children over the age of 2 with their lunch.	Ms. Blocker will be certain to always have low-fat milk to serve the children over 2 years of age.	06/30/2022
