Dear Ms. Lincoln:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 01/30/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Joann Lincoln did not have verification of completion of the 2021 Health and Safety refresher training.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED
Renewal Report dated 02/14/2022
Corrective Action plan dated 02/14/2022

R 400.1941 Heat-producing equipment.

(2) Combustible materials and equipment must not be stored within 4 feet of furnaces, other flame or heat-producing equipment, or fuel-fired water heaters.

At the time of the onsite inspection there were flammable items closed within 4 feet of the furnace.

R 400.1941 Heat-producing equipment.

(3) Portable heating devices must not be used when children are in care.

At the time of the onsite inspection a portable heating device was observed in use. The item was out of the reach of child care children.

- Joann Lincoln will supply the Radon Test Results from 2022 with the corrective action plan.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 02/18/2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
