

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS



Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

I observed the children during rest time, transition time, free play, and parent pick up. Ms. Wisniewski was engaged with the children and providing developmentally appropriate activities.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
