This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 06/29/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 07/18/2022. You can use our corrective action plan form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1942 Electrical service; maintenance.

(2) All electrical outlets, including outlets on multiple outlet devices, accessible to children must have safety covers or be tamper resistant outlets.

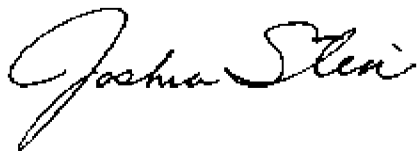
I found the bathroom outlet cover to be missing.

R 400.1944 Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.

(1) Operable smoke detectors approved by a nationally recognized testing laboratory must be installed and maintained on each floor of the home, including the basement, and in all sleeping areas and bedrooms used by children in care.

I found the two bedrooms that had sleeping stations to be missing smoke detectors.
