There is a swimming pool in the back yard. The sides of the pool are over four feet. There is also a locked gate on the deck leading to the swimming pool. The outdoor play area is fenced-in. There is a pond in the back yard; outside of the fenced-in play area. Children will be directly supervised in the fenced-in play area. An alarm was placed on the doors in the child care room to notify child care staff members when a door is opened.

There is an outdoor wood stove in the back yard. Children do not play in the back yard. The outdoor play area is fenced-in.

The children utilize the fenced-in play area. The outdoor wood stove is in the back yard.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Mrs. McDonald was present with two child care staff members, 14 child care children and 3 related children. I observed the children engaged in free play, snack, and outdoor play. The caregivers appeared bonded to the children and provided appropriate care and supervision.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided on the following:

- Mrs. McDonald has added alarms to the exit doors in the child care room.
- A discussion was held regarding R 400.1925.
- A discussion was held regarding R 400.1932(1).
- Mrs. McDonald purchased more ground cover for the play area. It will be installed in May.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home.
