R 400.1918(6)	During the inspection, there was a child with a peanut and penicillin allergy, a child with a penicillin allergy, and a child with an allergy to peanut butter. There was no plan on file for each of the three children indicating how their chronic medical condition will be accommodated during each type of emergency.	Ms. Kuhlman will return the medication to the parent until she receives a written order from the child's physician. To maintain compliance, Ms. Kuhlman will review all medications with parents prior to accepting them to ensure compliance with licensing rules.	12/06/2022

R 400.1945(2)(i)	During the inspection, I found an 18-month-old child with Children's Tylenol which indicates that it should not be given to a child under two years old without written order from a physician. There was no written order from this child's physician.	Ms. Kuhlman will develop plans for each child with a chronic medical condition. To maintain compliance, she will review records with parents every three months.	12/09/2022
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.
