III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct

observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

Upon arrival, there were eight children present with Ms. Amber Salenski and Ms. Venessa Salenski. Ms. Venessa Salenski was compliant with ratio rules. During the inspection, I observed snack time and free play. Ms. Amber Salenski and Ms. Venessa Salenski were observed being nurturing and caring toward the child care children. I observed Ms. Amber Salenski engaged in an interactive video with the children on two occasions. The children have access to a variety of age-appropriate toys and equipment in the home. Ms. Venessa Salenski's paperwork was very organized, and it is evident that she spends a great time of time reviewing her files and child care paperwork requirements. There is a large, fenced in outdoor play area containing a swing set, a slide, playhouses, a sandbox, and various outdoor equipment for the children. Ms. Salenski uses pea gravel as surfacing under the swings and there was a sufficient amount of surfacing in place.


The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided on the following:

- R 400.1945 (1)(e)- I instructed Ms. Salenski that there needs to be separate plans for active shooter, intruders, and lockdown.
- R 400.1945(2)(i)- I provided guidance on individual plans for children with chronic medical conditions and I provided her with individualized emergency plan templates for her to use.
- We discussed obtaining additional information from a doctor when a medical condition or allergy is listed to assist her with developing individualized emergency plans for the children.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the issuance of a regular license.
