These minimum meal requirements are based on the dietary guidelines for Americans made by the National Academy of Medicine, which are available at https://www.fns.usda.gov/cacfp/meals-and-snacks . This subrule does not apply to children whose parents provide their food."
R 400.1931(2)(c)	Children under 3 years of age shall not be served or allowed to eat foods that could easily cause choking including, but not limited to, popcorn and uncut round foods such as grapes, seeds, nuts, hard candy, and hot dogs."
R 400.1907(2)	Records in subrule (1) of this rule must be reviewed and updated annually or when information changes.
