III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

Ms. Bockhol lives in a ranch style home on a slab foundation in a rural residential area of Interlochen, Michigan.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use: The living room, dining room/kitchen, family room, and first bedroom on the south (right) side of the home are approved for child use.

Areas not approved: The master bedroom, second bedroom on the south side, and the bedroom on the north side of the home are not approved for child use.

Ages of children served: Ms. Bockhol will care for children from birth through 17 years of age.

Equipment: Ms. Bockhol has a variety of play equipment available for child use including pretend play items, baby dolls, books, puzzles, blocks, play vehicles, and infant toys.

Proposed days and hours of operation: Ms. Bockhol will operate from 7:00 AM until 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care: Ms. Bockhol was previously licensed as a child care family home provider under DF280094233 and DF280410718.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The front door exits to the front yard of the home. A remotely located sliding glass door off of the dining room provides a secondary exit to the back yard. A third exit off of the hallway between the family room and living room also exits into the back yard.

Outdoor play area description: The fenced outdoor play area is located in the front yard of the home. Children have access to balls, hoops, sleds, buckets, and other mobile outdoor equipment.

Additional information:

- Pets? No Yes If yes, describe. There are two cats and two Husky dogs in the home. The dogs will be crated during child care hours, but may have occasional contact with children. The cats may have occasional contact with children. There are also two guinea pigs in cages located in one of the non child care use bedrooms that will never be accessible to children in care.
- Hot tubs or spa pool? No Yes If yes, are there appropriate barriers?
- Swimming pool? No Yes If yes, describe pool and barriers. There is an above-ground swimming pool with 5 ft. high sides in the back yard. The fence around the outdoor play area in the front yard prevents children from gaining access to the pool in the back yard.
- Other water hazards? No Yes If yes, describe. There is a small pond in the front yard. The fence surrounding the play area prevents children from accessing the pond.
- Fireplace or wood burning stove? No Yes If yes, describe. There is a wood burning fireplace in the family room that is rarely used.
- Fireplace/wood burner in use during child care hours? No Yes If yes, describe barriers to protect children from burns:



I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).


