Dear Ms. Beeson:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 03/31/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

When I arrived on-site, Ms. Carrie Jo Beeson was present with five children in attendance. I observed the children eating lunch, washing their hands, playing and resting. Ms. Beeson had a good rapport with each of the children and the children appeared happy and comfortable within her care.

Technical assistance and consultation were provided to Ms. Beeson in the following areas:

- **R400.1907(1)(a) Child's record.** Ensure that all child information cards have a recorded date of admission and "none" or "unknown" are used when completing the special needs and allergy section.
- **R400.1907(2) Child's record.** Child information cards and child in care statements must be reviewed and updated annually.
- **R400.1905(9) Training.** Ms. Beeson needs to follow-up with MiRegistry as to why the Ongoing Health and Safety Training 2021 is not showing as "completed".
- **R400.1905(3)(a) Training.** Ensure that child care staff member Ms. Kathy Blizzard's safe sleep training is completed and on file.
- **R400.1943(5) Exit requirements for each floor level used by children.** Ensure that the path to the exit window in the basement is kept clear and unobstructed at all times.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.
