- R400.1933(4) Water supply; sewage disposal; water temperature.

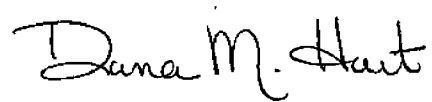

Approved child use space: On the main level, the living/dining room is approved for child care use. In the basement, the main room, window room and the laundry room are approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two exits on the main level. A door in the living room leads out to a cement landing with five steps down to the driveway. A door in the kitchen leads out to an enclosed entryway which has four steps down to a door that leads directly out to the side yard. There are two exits in the basement. The main staircase leads to a door which exits directly out to the side yard. The egress window, located in the window room, easily opens, is identified with an exit sign, is low enough to be accessible to child care children, leads out to a window well with steps on the side of the window well, which lead out to the front yard.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

When I arrived on-site, Ms. Carrie Beeson was present; along with five children in attendance. The children were engaged in free choice time. Ms. Beeson was attending to the two infants in care. The children were observed playing with puzzles, games and books. The children appeared happy and comfortable within Ms. Beeson's care and were familiar with the routine and expectations. Child care staff member, Ms. Kathy Blizzard arrived as I was leaving the home.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1905

Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(a) Safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome.

Ms. Kathy Blizzard had not completed safe sleep training prior to caring for child care children on 02/09/2022.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

LSR dated: 02/28/2020

Corrective Action Plan dated: 02/06/2020

R 400.1933

Water supply; sewage disposal; water temperature.

(4) Hot water temperature must not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit at water faucets accessible to children.

The water temperature in the hand washing sink tested at 138 degrees Fahrenheit.


Technical Assistance and consultation was provided to Ms. Carrie Beeson in the following areas:

- **R400.1925(2)(e) Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.** Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.
- **R400.1907 Child's records.** Update the child information forms and child in care statements.
- **R400.1932(1) Home maintenance and safety.** Replace the broken light cover in the window room.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 02/14/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
