II. Purpose of Addendum

On 09/30/2022, Ms. Hannah Purvis requested the removal of the bedroom (NW) and the bedroom (W) on the main level of the home from the approved child use space; and the addition of the bathroom in the basement for use by the child care children.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 09/30/2022; 08/29/2022; 11/19/2021; 11/13/2018 and 10/11/2016.

A. Description of Facility

This group child care home is a one-story wood-framed structure with a partially finished, walk-out basement. The home is located on a rural road in Ithaca.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use:

On the basement level of the home, the playroom and the eating area (located North of the basement stairs) are approved for child care use. On the main level of the home, the kitchen, dining room, family room (N), living room (SE) and the bedroom (SW) are approved for child care use. There is a bathroom on the basement level of the home and a bathroom located in the hallway, on the main level of the home, that area available for use by the child care children.

Areas not approved:

On the basement level of the home, the furnace room, the storage room (East) and the counter top/sink area (located south of the basement stairs) are not approved for child care use. On the main level of the home, the bedroom (NW) and the bedroom (W) are not approved for child care use.

Ages of children served:

Ms. Purvis will care for children birth thru 17 years.

Equipment:

Ms. Purvis has a more than adequate amount of developmentally appropriate indoor and outdoor play equipment for the children to interact with and use.

Proposed days and hours of operation:

Ms. Purvis will provide care Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Previous or concurrent licenses:

Ms. Purvis has previously been licensed to provide child care (DG290282387) at another residence. There are no concurrent licenses, including children’s foster care.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement):

On the basement level, there are two exits available: the main stairway that leads up to the main level of the home and an exit door, located in the play room, that exits directly out to the driveway on the west side of the home. On the main level of the home, there are four exits available: the front door, located off of the dining room, which exits out to a wooden deck that steps down to the front yard; two doors, located in the family room (N), which exit out to wooden steps that lead down to the backyard; and one door, located in the living room (SE), which exits out to the garage.

Outdoor play area and description:

The driveway, located just outside the basement level exit door, and a fenced in grassy area, located north of the driveway, are both available for use by the child care children. The outdoor wooden playset is not used by the child care children. There are no water hazards on or near the property.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the removal of the bedroom (NW) and the bedroom (W) on the main level of the home from the approved child use space; and the addition of the bathroom in the basement for use by the child care children.
