Pool and water troughs.	The outdoor play area is the grassy area surrounding the home, which is not fenced. There are water troughs located inside the cow pasture. The cow pasture fencing meets the 4 ft. minimum height requirement. The gates are kept locked to prevent children from gaining access to the water troughs in the pasture. All other watering dishes for the animals are kept within their fenced in areas. There is an above ground pool which sides meet the 4 ft. minimum. There are no other water hazards on the property.	


