Dear Ms. Campis:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 01/31/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in the recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905**Training.**

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in the prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905**Training.**

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(a) Child development.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in child development. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905**Training.**

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(b) Administration of medication.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in the administration of medication. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(c) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in the prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(d) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in the handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905**Training.**

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(e) Precautions in transporting children.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in precautions in transporting children. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905**Training.**

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(f) Building and physical premises safety.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in building and physical premises safety. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1905**Training.**

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

At the time of the onsite inspection, Lindsey Lapka, child care staff member, had not completed training in all hazards emergency preparedness and response planning. Ms. Lapka began employment in August of 2020 and completed annual health and safety updates for 2020 and 2021. Ms. Lapka did not complete the original Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2.

R 400.1910

Ratio of personnel to children.

(1) The ratio of personnel to children present in the home at any 1 time must be not less than 1 member of the personnel to 6 children. The ratio must include all children in care who are not related to any personnel and any of the following children who are less than 6 years of age:

- (a) Children of the licensee.
- (b) Children of a child care staff member or child care assistant.
- (c) Children related to any member of the household by blood, marriage, or adoption.

At the time of the onsite inspection, I observed Ms. Campis caring for seven unrelated child care children without an additional child care staff member. Ms. Campis stated it was a no school day for a local school district. Ms. Campis will inform parents of enrolled children that without an additional child care staff member she would only be able to care for six unrelated child care children at one time.

On 01/31/2022, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.

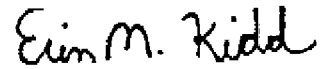
