R 400.1905(3)(a)	Four out of four child care staff members did not have proof of training in their file or on MiRegistry for safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome prior to caring for children.	All child care staff members will enroll in Safe Sleep on MiRegistry. Proof of completion will be printed and placed in their file. Moving forward, any new child care staff members will complete Safe Sleep as part of orientation.	11/30/2022

R 400.1905(3)(c)	Two child care staff members did not have proof of training in their file or in MiRegistry on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.	All child care staff members will complete shaken baby, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment through MiRegistry. Proof of completion will be printed and placed in their files. Any new child care staff members will complete shaken baby, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment as part of orientation.	12/31/2022
R 400.1906(1)(g)	Two child care staff members did not have a written statement, signed and dated indicating they are aware that abuse and neglect of children was unlawful, that he or she is mandated by law to report child abuse and neglect and that they received a copy of the licensee's discipline policy.	Child abuse and neglect statements will be completed for Katie and Jadiwga and will be placed in their file. Any new child care staff member will complete a child abuse and neglect statement upon hire.	11/30/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
