Dear Ms. Williams:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 10/26/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During the onsite inspection I observed free choice, snack, diapering, hand washing and nap. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate. Ms. Williams uses the Mother Goose curriculum with a different theme each month.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1903 Licensee responsibilities.

(7) The licensee shall cooperate with the department by ensuring that all individuals requiring a comprehensive background check are entered into the child care background check system and processed for eligibility as required by sections 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, 722.115q, and R 400.1925.

One child care staff member did not have a comprehensive background check entered into the background check system and processed for eligibility.

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(a) Safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome.

Four out of four child care staff members did not have proof of training in their file or on MiRegistry on safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome prior to caring for children.

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

Two child care staff members did not have proof of training in their file or on MiRegistry on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment prior to caring for children.

R 400.1906(1)(g) Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.

(1) A licensee shall maintain a file for each child car staff member and each child care assistant that includes the following:

(g) A written statement, signed and dated by the child care staff member or child care assistant at the time of hiring, indicating all of the following information:

(i) The individual is aware that abuse and neglect of children is unlawful.
(ii) The individual knows that he or she is mandated by law to report child abuse and neglect.

(iii) The individual has received a copy of the licensee's discipline policy.

Two child care staff members did not have a written statement, signed and dated indicating they are aware that abuse and neglect of children was unlawful, that he or she is mandated by law to report child abuse and neglect and that they received a copy of the licensee's discipline policy.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 11/16/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Due to the infant safe sleep violation(s), all of your infant caregivers must take training on infant safe sleep. This must be included in your corrective action plan. In addition, a follow up inspection may be made to check compliance with the infant safe sleep rules.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
