

Approved child use space: On the main level of the home the playroom, kitchen, dining room, and family room are approved. On the second level two bedrooms are approved. Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two remote exits on the main level of the home. The staircase leading to the main level and a window are the two remote exits on the second level of the home. The basement has stairs which lead to the main level of the home. The basement is not approved for child care use. However, the basement is used for tornado drills and emergencies.

Approved variances - No Yes Description: There is an approved variance increasing the capacity to 14 children. This is reviewed at each inspection for appropriateness. No concerns were noted.

Key Indicator Inspection: This was not a key indicator inspection.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular renewal license to this group home child care.
