

Approved child use space: Ms. Hudcocky lives in a single story home with a basement. The main level of the home is approved for child care. The living room, kitchen, playroom and one bedroom are approved for child care use. The basement is not approved for child care and can only be used for tornado drills.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There is a front door, side door, and several windows at the back of the home that can be used for emergency escape on the main level.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1905                      Training**

**(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.**

Ms. Hudcosky's child care staff member had not completed the 2022 health and safety refresher course.

**R 400.1906                      Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.**

**(1) A licensee shall maintain a file for each child care staff member and each child care assistant that includes all of the following:**

**(c) A statement signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee that attests to the individual's mental and physical health., and which must be updated as follows:**

**(i) For an applicant or licensee, within 1 year before issuance of the initial license and at the time of subsequent renewals.**

**(ii) For a child care staff member and a child care assistant, within 1 year prior to caring for children and at the time of subsequent renewals of the child care home's license.**


Ms. Hudcosky and her child care staff member had not completed a physical evaluation for this renewal.

**REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED**  
**Renewal Inspection Report dated 02/23/2021**  
**Corrective Action Plan dated 02/17/2021**

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 12/20/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
