Dear Ms. Montano:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 02/09/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.

During the inspection, I observed naptime. Ms. Montano reported she does not use the two swing sets in the outdoor play area. I discussed the rules regarding ground cover and spacing. I explained she is unable to use climbing equipment over hard packed dirt, cement, or similar ground cover. I explained one of her swing sets is in a location that makes it impossible to meet the rules. Ms. Montano stated she does not use the swing sets/climbing equipment and will not use it until she either comes into compliance or removes it from the licensed outdoor play area. She again stated she does not use either piece of equipment.

Great start to quality was discussed with Ms. Montano.

The following rules were reviewed with Ms. Montano:

R400.1913: Discipline; child handling.

R400.1914: Daily activity program. Ms. Montano stated she does not use a particular curriculum, but she does activities with the children to help them learn and develop.

R400.1916: Bedding and sleeping equipment. Specifically, it was discussed that she read the instruction manuals of all cribs and/or pack and play equipment she uses for sleeping as there are height and weight restrictions for these two types of sleeping equipment.

R400.1920: Outdoor play equipment.

R400.1932: Home maintenance and safety.

R400.1945: Emergency; plan; drill.

R400.1944: Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.


