### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the onsite inspection, I observed free choice, lunch, diapering, snack, naptime and departure. Ms. Babahaami uses 1-2-3 Learning curriculum to plan daily activities. Each week the curriculum focuses on a theme that includes one letter, shape, color, and number. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate.

Technical assistance was given on the recall list, discipline policy, and handwashing.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
