Approved child use space: The main play area is located in the lower-level basement and is approved for child care use. On the main level, the dining area and four seasons room are approved for child care use and the master bedroom is approved for infants napping in cribs or play yards. The kitchen and living room were added as approved use space during the inspection.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): Exits on the main level include front and rear doorways that both lead directly outside. Exits on the lower-level basement include stairs to the main level and an exit window in the main lay area. The window is appropriately sized to allow for the safe evacuation of child care staff members and children in accordance with R400.1943(3).

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes. During the onsite inspection I observed arrival, free choice, and snack. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate. Mrs. Al-Saedi uses the 1-2-3 program for learning.

Technical assistance was given on child information cards, child in care statements, child abuse and neglect statement, and the 3-step process for cleaning the diaper pad.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
