

Approved child use space: Kitchen/dining room, family room, living room, and basement are all approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are three exits on the main floor of the home. The first exit is the front door off of the living room which provides egress to the front yard. The second exit is the garage door off of the kitchen area which provides egress to the garage and the front or back yard. The third exit is the sliding glass door in the family room which provides egress to the back yard. The basement has two exits. The first exit is the stairway that provides egress to the main floor of the home. The second exit is an egress window which provides egress to the side of the home.


III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS
