

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:**  
**(b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.**

Two child care staff members have not completed health and safety course 1 and 2 prior to caring for children.

**(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:**  
**(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.**

Two child care staff members have not completed health and safety course 1 and 2 prior to caring for children.

**(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the required topics.**

**(6) Completion of the required training must be verified by a document, signed by the trainer or an authorized individual, which must be kept on file or available online at MiRegistry.**


**(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.**

4 child care staff members did not complete the 2021 health and safety refresher in 2021.

3 child care staff members did not complete the 2022 health and safety refresher in 2022.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular group home childcare license (capacity 7-12).
