

Approved child use space: The basement child care rooms are approved for child care use. The living room, dining room, and kitchen on the first floor are approved for occasional child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are three exits in the basement level of the home. The first exit is the stairs which provides egress to the main level of the home. The second exit is the egress window in the infant nap room which provides egress to the back of the home. The third exit is the egress window near the kitchen in the basement which provides egress to the back of the home. The main level has two exits. The first exit is the front door which provides egress to the front of the home. The second exit is the garage door which provides egress to the garage and the front yard of the home.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS



Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Consultation was provided to Ms. Evans in the area of training documentation. It is necessary to have all training documentation for staff organized onsite or on MiRegistry. This includes CPR/First Aid training.

I recommend issuance of a original license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
