

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1905

Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Ms Keagle and Child Care Staff Member 1 lacked MI Registry Health and Safety refresher trainings.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 05/08/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

Ms. Keagle has a variety of play and learning equipment. The children are provided with both structured and freedom of choice learning. I observe the children engaged in meal service, freedom of choice learning, and reading.

I provided a rule review regarding:

Written crisis management and emergency plans.

Child information cards and assuring no blanks or N/A.

Health and Safety training requirements for staff and unsupervised volunteers.

Infant safe sleep review.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend renewal of the child care group license.
