The main level and upper level of the home are not approved for child use space.

There is an above ground swimming pool. It is surrounded by a deck that is higher than 4 ft above the ground. The deck has stairs leading to the ground level. The gate leading from the stairs to the pool is locked with a lock not easily opened by children.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Ms. Hackworth provides the children with both structured and freedom of choice learning opportunities. I observed the children engaged in freedom of choice learning, meal time, and quiet time activities. I provided a rule review regarding infant safe sleep rules.
