This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct



Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the on-site inspection, the children were engaged in quiet time activities and freedom of choice learning. I provided a rule review regarding different ways and places to obtain training hours, and a safe sleep rule review, including approved and not approved bedding for infants.
