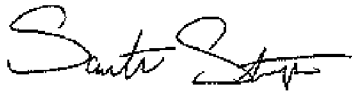

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my onsite inspection I observed free play. Interactions between Mrs. May and child care children were positive.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1903 Licensee responsibilities.

(7) The licensee shall cooperate with the department by ensuring that all individuals requiring a comprehensive background check are entered into the child care background check system and processed for eligibility as required by section 5n of the act, MCL722.115n, and R 400.1925.

An adult household member was not entered into CCBC and processed for eligibility prior to moving into the child care home as required.

R 400.1905 Training.

(7) CPR and first aid training certification must be maintained according to the expiration dates on the individual's certification cards.

Mr. and Mrs. May did not maintain their CPR and first aid training certificate as they both expired on 01/2021.

R 400.1919

Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(1) An applicant shall obtain a written statement, signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee within 1 year before issuance of the initial license, that attests to the applicant's mental and physical health. The attestation must be renewed at the time of subsequent license renewals.

Mrs. May, Licensee and Mr. May child care staff member, did not renew their medical clearance attesting to their mental and physical health prior to renewal as required.

R 400.1919

Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

A minor household member older than 14 years of age did not have written evidence of freedom from tuberculosis prior to living in the child care home.

R 400.1941

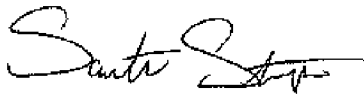
Heat-producing equipment.

(5) The inspection specified in subrule (4) of this rule must be conducted before the initial license is issued and every 4 years thereafter at the time of license renewal.

A new furnace and hot water heater inspection was not completed prior to renewal as required.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular child care license to this group home.
