

The home is a two story home with a basement. On the main level the back entryway, kitchen, formal dining room, living room, and the play room are approved for child care use. The bedroom in the northwest corner on the second level of the home is approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main level uses two remote doors for exits. The second floor has a designated emergency window exit and stairs leading to the main level for exits.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Ms. Lippmann provides the children with both structured and freedom of choice learning. She has a variety of play and learning equipment. I observed the children engaged in free choice learning. I provided a rule review regarding infant safe sleep, the comprehensive background check system, and the written crisis management plan as it relates to infants and toddlers. I provided suggestions on different organizing techniques for staff files.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend renewal of this child care group license.
