Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

During the onsite inspection I observed meal time, nap time, diapering, handwashing, and free choice time. Interactions between child care staff members were positive and developmentally appropriate.
