Moving forward the instructions on the pack n play and the Consumer Product Safety Commission requirements for pack n plays will be followed.	Immediately and ongoing for ensuring pack and plays are used in accordance with licensing and consumer product safety commission requirements. Safe sleep will be completed 5/10/2024.
R 400.1934(7)	The room being used to nap children did not have adequate natural or artificial lighting.	The rooms used for napping now have natural or artificial light sufficient enough to be able to observe the children. All child care	Immediately and ongoing.

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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.
