R 400.1944(3) Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.	The fire extinguishers on both the main level of the home and the second level of the home were not properly mounted. R 400.1952(2) Child transportation; parent permission; child information card; required when off-premises.	The licensee did not obtain written permission from children's parents for the child to go on walking field trips in the neighborhood at the time of initial enrollment. It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
