IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions


Veronica Marion operates a group child care home. The current approved use space is the main floor kitchen, living room, dining room, and master bedroom.

A modification request was submitted to approve the basement playroom and craft room. The basement living room area is not approved for use. The playroom and craft room will be used for preschool aged children and older. The playroom has an approved window exit. The ledge to the window measures 27 inches from the floor, this does not require steps and a platform to access the window.

There is a fireplace in the basement living room. This will be used when children are in care. There is a barrier to prevent access to the fireplace by children in care.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the approval of the basement playroom and craft room for use by children in care.
