Approved child use space: On the upper level one bedroom is approved as child use space. On the main level the living room, dining room, and kitchen are approved as child use space. The basement level of the home is approved as child use space. Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two remotely located exits on the upper level of the home; the stairs to the main level and a window labeled as an exit in the approved bedroom. On the main level there are two remotely located exits; the front door and a back door leading to the back yard of the home. In the basement level there are two remotely located exits; the stairs to the main level and a window with built in steps (grandfathered in).

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my on-site inspection the home was clean. Children in attendance were watching age-appropriate television programming. Ms. Holden and the child care staff member, Dariasha Garmon were providing care and supervision. Home, staff, and child files were made readily available.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on training requirements, staff, and child files, posting of emergency plans and procedures, maintaining exits unobstructed and maintaining a four-foot clearance around the furnace and water heater.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1934(4) Heating; ventilation; lighting; radon.**

(4) A licensee shall test the child care home for the concentration of radon gas before the initial license is issued and every 4 years thereafter at the time of license renewal.

The last radon test on file is from 2018. Ms. Holden stated she had not completed a more recent radon test.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care home.
