Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I saw children engaged in free play and nap. There was a variety of age-appropriate materials and equipment for the children to access. Daevwana DeBose interacted with children in a positive and nurturing manner. The home, staff, and child records were made readily available.

During the renewal inspection, licensing consultant Jessica Miranda-Bevier found 1 violation. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 5/10/2024. A regular license will be issued.
