III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct

observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1903 Caregiver Responsibilities.

(1) A caregiver shall be responsible for all of the following provisions:

(f) Have a written and signed agreement with a responsible person who is 18 years of age or older to provide care and supervision for children during an emergency situation.

The emergency caregiver statement on file must be updated as the emergency caregiver listed in the current statement is not available to provide care and supervision for children during an emergency situation.

R 400.1932 Home maintenance and safety.

(1) The structure, premises, and furnishings of a child care home shall be in good repair and maintained in a clean, safe, and comfortable condition.

The laminate floor covering on the main level of the home is torn and in poor repair causing a tripping hazard for children.

The chair and sofa located in the living room are badly torn and in poor repair.

R 400.1932 Home maintenance and safety.

(6) There shall be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces, equipment, and toys accessible to children.

There is flaking/peeling paint around the door frame of the front entry door.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this group child care home (7-12)
