In the basement, the large play and large napping area are both approved child care space. The upstairs level, the two bedrooms on the left side and the one at the end of the hallway are all approved child care use space.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The front door and the glass slider located in the eat-in-kitchen both serve as exits for the main level. The back door located in the napping room and the stairs leading to the garage door both serve as exits for the basement. The window in the located in the second bedroom and the stairs leading to the front door both serve as exits for the upstairs.

The fireplace will not be used during child care hours.


III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS
