Dear Heather and Robert:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 09/18/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Two child care staff members did not have proof of training that included information on the recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect prior to caring for children.

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

Two child care staff members did not have proof of training on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment prior to caring for children.

On 09/20/2023, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.

During the onsite inspection I observed free choice, art, snack, group time, and small groups. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate. Ms. Hall uses the Mother Goose and Experience curriculum with the children in care. Technical assistance was given on the 3-step process for cleaning, child information cards, child in care statements, indoor swings, and hand washing.
