This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 05/17/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Child care staff member (T.P.) did not complete the training on Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

T.P. completed the Health and Safety Training Part 1 on 02/19/2021.

Please note: *Health and Safety Training for Licensed Child Care Providers Course 2* includes training on Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

Child care staff member (T.P.) did not complete the training on Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

T.P. completed the Health and Safety Training Part 1 on 02/19/2021.

Please note: *Health and Safety Training for Licensed Child Care Providers Course 2 includes* training on Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(d) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(e) Precautions in transporting children.

Child care staff member (T.P.) did not complete the training on Precautions in transporting children.

T.P. completed the Health and Safety Training Part 1 on 02/19/2021.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(f) Building and physical premises safety.

Child care staff member (T.P.) did not complete the training on Building and physical premises safety.

T.P. completed the Health and Safety Training Part 1 on 02/19/2021.

Please note: *Health and Safety Training for Licensed Child Care Providers Course 2 includes* training on Building and physical premises safety.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

Child care staff member (T.P.) did not complete the training on All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

T.P. completed the Health and Safety Training Part 1 on 02/19/2021.

Please note: *Health and Safety Training for Licensed Child Care Providers Course 2* includes training on All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

R 400.1905 Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Mrs. Pettit and child care staff member (K.K.) did not complete the Refresher 2021 training.

R 400.1944 Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.

(3) A home shall have at least 1 functioning multipurpose fire extinguisher, with a rating of 2A-10BC or larger, properly mounted not higher than 5 feet from the floor to the top of the fire extinguisher, on each floor level approved for child use.

The child care home does not have a fire extinguisher with a rating of 2A-10BC.

The child care home had two fire extinguishers with a rating of 1 BC.

On May 17, 2022, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.
