### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection the programming I observed included the following: nap time, hand washing, snack, free play, and diapering. I observed the caregiver's interactions with the children in care to be developmentally appropriate and responsive to their needs.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the exit conference, I provided technical assistance and consultation to Ms. Becker on the following: date of admission must be completed on all child information cards and a separate garbage for diapering supplies is required.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 12).
