
R 400.1905(7) Training.	Two child care staff members did not have current training in CPR and first aid.	Ms. Piekutowski will have all child care staff members missing current CPR/first aid training complete the training.	08/20/2023
R 400.1905(9) Training.	The licensee did not have the 2021 or 2022 refresher trainings completed.	Ms. Piekutowski will complete the missing refresher trainings.	08/20/2023

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
