Dear Ms. Trudelle:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 11/21/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

Child care staff member Svetlana Djurovski had not completed the required trainings through MiRegistry (Health and Safety course 1 and course 2) that is required prior to them caring for children.

R 400.1905 Training.

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Child care staff member Rachel Miller failed to complete the 2021 refresher training through MiRegistry in 2021 as required.

R 400.1916 Bedding and sleeping equipment.

(8) Soft objects, bumper pads, stuffed toys, blankets, quilts or comforters, pillows, and other objects that could smother an infant must not be placed with, under, or within reach of a resting or sleeping infant.

There was a sleeping infant in a portable play yard and there was a sleep sack blanket draped over the play yard.

R 400.1919 Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

Child care staff member Ms. Djurovski did not have a TB test that was dated showing a negative TB test result.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 1/15/2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.

- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Due to the infant safe sleep violation(s), all of your infant caregivers must take training on infant safe sleep. This must be included in your corrective action plan. In addition, a follow up inspection may be made to check compliance with the infant safe sleep rules.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
