## II. Purpose of Addendum

To approve the family room on the main floor of the home for sick children, napping and quiet activities.

## III. Methodology

03/08/2023 – Inspection completed onsite.

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the license have been modified on March 13, 2023. The licensee requested during the renewal onsite inspection on March 8, 2023, to approve the family room on the main floor level to separate sick children, for napping, and quiet activities. There is a combo carbon monoxide/smoke detector installed in this room to allow for napping in this room. This is the only room on the main floor that is approved for child use. The second-floor level is also not approved for child use.

The basement continues as the primary area for childcare use. There is an abundance of quality equipment located in the basement that is sufficient for the approved capacity. Sleeping equipment consists of cots, full size cribs and portable play yards.

The outdoor play area is completely enclosed with a fence. Elevated play structures have the required shock absorbing material as required. There is a hot tub on the outdoor play area that has a hard cover and has the required latches. Ms. Daniel is aware that direct supervision of child is always required, while outdoors.

The following areas are approved for child use:

- The entire basement except the area where the furnace is housed.
- The family room on the main floor.

## V. Recommendation

I recommend the approval of the family room on the main floor level as approved child use space.
