IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions


On 05/02/2022, I conducted an onsite inspection to approve the basement for child care use. There are two rooms and a bathroom in the bathroom that will be used for child care. The licensee had an egress window installed along with an additional smoke detector, carbon monoxide detector and fire extinguisher.

The kitchen, living room, dining room and one bedroom on the main floor were previously approved and will continue to be used by children in care.

The licensee has also requested a change in hours to provide child care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The licensee was previously providing 24 hour care, six days a week.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the two rooms and bathroom in the basement for child care use. I also approve the change in hours to now include 24 hour care, 7 days a week.
