

Approved child use space: The main level, second level and basement areas of the home are approved for child care use. This includes the living room on the main level, the play room (bedroom), nursery (bedroom), blue room (bedroom), purple room (bedroom), two bathrooms on the second floor and the child care room in the basement.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The exits on the main level are the front and side doors. The second level exits are the steps leading down to main level, a window exit located in master bedroom and the hallway on the side of the duplex where steps lead to the family residence and outside. The basement level exits are the steps leading up to main level, door on one side of basement, egress window on other side of basement.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, I observed children engaged in developmentally appropriate outdoor play. The equipment was arranged in zones and provided multiple opportunities for exploratory play and learning.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
